

Notice Issued under Regulation 9 of the Local Authorities (Executive Arrangements) (Meetings and Access to Information) (England) Regulations 2012 of the intention to make a Key Decision on behalf of the Local Authority.

Regulation 9 of the above Regulations requires 28 clear-days notice of a decision-making body's intention to make a key decision.

Regulation 11 states that where the date by which a decision must be made makes compliance with this regulation impracticable, the decision may only be made where the decision maker has obtained agreement from the Chairman of the relevant overview and scrutiny committee that the making of the decision is urgent and cannot reasonably be deferred.

Approval for this item to be considered by the Cabinet on 9 January 2019 was received from Councillor D Knights (Chairman of the Improvement & Review Commission) who agreed that the decision could not reasonably be deferred.
